Over the past 20 years, Darren has been instrumental in negotiating equity and debt financing packages totaling more than \$800 million and has significant experience leading teams in emerging markets with a strong focus on Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) and community engagement programs as well as extensive government relations activities.
