

MARGARET SKOK - BIO Summary - 2023

Margaret Skok is a Senior Fellow at Carleton University/NPSIA (Norman Paterson School of International Affairs). Over her 40 years with the Government of Canada in several resources sector departments, her focus has been on trade policy, employment development, security and international business. In addition to M. Skok's work in Ottawa, Montreal and Toronto – she has served with the Embassy of Canada in Moscow where she managed Canada's agriculture trade relations and debt servicing. Margaret also served as Canada's Ambassador to the Republic of Kazakhstan, with concurrent accreditation to the Kyrgyz Republic and the Republic of Tajikistan.

Since retirement from Canada's public service, Margaret has worked with the Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission, participated as an accredited Canadian observer with OSCE/ODIHR to elections in Belarus, Ukraine and Kazakhstan. She has worked as a consultant to Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada, the Canadian Border Services Agency, the University of Central Asia, Carleton University, and Global Affairs Canada.

Margaret Skok is a member of the Ottawa chapter of the Organization of Women in International Trade (OWIT), and the Canada Eurasia Chamber of Commerce (CECC). She is a recipient of a Deputy Minister's Award for exceptional and distinguished contribution to the Canadian public service, and a Senate Award for Women in International Business.
